# The Yorkshire Three Peaks Challenge (in aid of WellChild) Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> May 2010

*Bryony Aveyard from York, was only 11 years old when she was struck down suddenly with a massive brain haemorrhage. Following her tragic death Bryony's family are determined to raise as much money as possible in her memory and to help fund a WellChild Nurse.*

*WellChild is the national charity for sick children who are committed to help sick children and their families throughout the UK as they deal with the consequences of serious illness and complex conditions.*

The **Yorkshire Three Peaks** is one of the oldest established walks in the UK. Starting at Holme Farm camp site, Horton in Ribblesdale it comprises Pen-y-ghent (694m), Wharfedale (736m) and Ingleborough (723m). The distance is approx 25 miles and takes between 8–14 hours to complete.

This fully-supported, circular challenge is to complete the three peaks whilst raising as much money as possible for the Love of Bryony Fund. A minimum sponsorship target of £25 is requested.
