

Best Dressed Party Animal Competition

Pippa's Parrot Costume

- **Feathers are a must for a parrot costume!** Use felt or coloured card to cut feather shapes out, layer these and stick them with glue or use glue dots (you may need to ask a grown up to help you)
- **Be colourful.** I like to be as colourful as possible! Use a minimum of 3 colours to make your parrot costume stand out
- **Add a parrot mask to complete your look.** Create your own Parrot mask using coloured paper and a paper plate. Make sure you ask an adult to help you when using scissors. Colour it in to match the rest of your costume! Ask a grown up to help you cut the mask out and add elastic/a ribbon to tie it around your head.



Monkey Costume

- **Create your monkey ears.** Use two shades of brown felt or card, cut out two semi-circles in each colour, the lighter brown semi-circle should be smaller and fit inside the darker brown. Stick these together with glue and then glue the ears on to a headband. You may need a grown up to help you with this. Then you should have something like this:
- **Dress in brown or grey clothes.** You can dress in anything you like, maybe a t-shirt and leggings/trousers
- **Complete your monkey outfit with a tail!** Cut out a monkey tail shape from brown or grey felt, wrap the top end around some string or ribbon long enough to tie around your waist, and stick this down with glue. You may need a grown up to help you with this.
