You will support families who do not have the means to provide a safe and accessible outside environment for their child's needs.



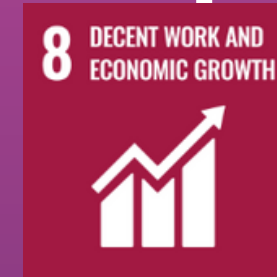
Good health and wellbeing (SDG 3)
